SCRAPIE MONITORING/TEMPORARY SCRAPIE EXPORT REGISTER

The proposed arrangement effectively divides Sheep and Goats into seasonal and non-seasonal breeders and attempts to define periods when transmission of disease is minimized.

Shows requiring Scrapie monitored negative approval can be held from 1st May to 31st August.

Females of all breeds of Sheep and Goats (except Dorset Horn, Polled Dorset and Finnish Landrace) to be entered and/or exhibited are:

- i. Non Pregnant (empty)
- ii. Have not lambed/kidded within 30 days prior to the show
- iii. Are not subject to procedures which change the seasonal breeding pattern

MAEDI VISNA ACCREDITED SHEEP

Maedi Visna accredited sheep exhibitors must ensure they have a Health Status Report which is valid for the date of the show – a completed copy of this MUST accompany their sheep on show day. Sheep MUST NOT be unloaded without a valid Health Status Report.

GOATS

All goats must be CAE Accredited and have a current CAE certificate, a copy of which should accompany the entry form.
